GENESIS

1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

2:3 So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all his work which he had done in creation.

2:15 The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it.

3:9 But the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?"

6:6 And the LORD was sorry that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart.

7:6 Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters came upon the earth.

8:20 Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

32:30 So Jacob called the name of the place Peni'el, saying, "For I have seen God face to face, and yet my life is preserved."

35:15 So Jacob called the name of the place where God had spoken with him, Bethel.

EXODUS

2:2 The woman conceived and bore a son; and when she saw that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

3:5 Then he said, "Do not come near; put off your shoes from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."

3:14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel, `I AM has sent me to you.'"

15: 3 The LORD is a man of war;
the LORD is his name.

15:18 The LORD will reign for ever and ever."

17:11 Whenever Moses held up his hand, Israel prevailed; and whenever he lowered his hand, Am'alek prevailed.

17:15 And Moses built an altar and called the name of it, The LORD is my banner,

20:3 "You shall have no other gods before me.

31:5 in cutting stones for setting, and in carving wood, for work in every craft.

32:16 And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables.

32:33 But the LORD said to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

34:14 (for you shall worship no other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God),

35:5 Take from among you an offering to the LORD; whoever is of a generous heart, let him bring the LORD's offering: gold, silver, and bronze;

LEVITICUS

8:10 Then Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that was in it, and consecrated them.

8:12 And he poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head, and anointed him, to consecrate him.

11:44 For I am the LORD your God; consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy. You shall not defile yourselves with any swarming thing that crawls upon the earth.

28:3 But God said to me, 'You may not build a house for my name, for you are a warrior and have shed blood.'

29:13 And now we thank thee, our God, and praise thy glorious name.

2 CHRONICLES

2:5 The house which I am to build will be great, for our God is greater than all gods.

but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.
