# OLD TESTAMENT

## GENESIS

- 1:3** Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.
- 1:27** So God created humankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.
- 2:3** So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all the work that he had done in creation.
- 2:15** The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it.
- 3:9** But the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?"
- 6:6** And the LORD was sorry that he had made humankind on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart.
- 7:5** And Noah did all that the Lord had commanded him.
- 8:20** Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.
- 12:2** And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
- 15:6** And he believed the LORD; and he reckoned it to him as righteousness.
- 17:2** And I will make my covenant between me and you, and will make you exceedingly numerous.
- 28:3** "Make God Almighty bless you and make you fruitful and numerous, that you may become a company of peoples."
- 28:22** "and this stone, which I have set up for a pillar, shall be God's house; and of all that you give me, I will surely give one tenth to you."
- 32:30** So Jacob called the name of the place Penuel, saying, "For I have seen God face to face, and yet my life is preserved."
- 35:3** Then come, let us go up to Bethel, that I may make there an altar to the God who answered me in the day of my distress and have been with me wherever I have gone."
- 35:15** So Jacob called the name of the place where God had spoken with him, Bethel.
- 39:21** But the LORD was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love; and gave him favour in the sight of the chief jailer.
- 49:18** I wait for thy salvation, O LORD.

 **EXODUS**

- 1:8** Now a new king arose over Egypt, who did not know Joseph.
- 2:2** The woman conceived and bore a son; and when she saw that he was a fine baby, she hid him three months.
- 3:2** There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of a bush; he looked, and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed.
- 4:2** The LORD said to him, "What is that in your hand?" He said, "A staff."
- 5:20** As they left Pharaoh, they came upon Moses and Aaron who were waiting to meet them.
- 7:6** Moses and Aaron did so; they did just as the LORD commanded them.
- 8:2** If you refuse to let them go, I will plague your whole country with frogs.
- 10:29** Moses said, "Just as you say! I will never see your face again."
- 12:28** The Israelites went and did just as the LORD had commanded Moses and Aaron.
- 16:19** And Moses said to them, "Let no one leave any of it over until morning."
- 19:9** Then the LORD said to Moses, "I am going to come to you in a dense cloud, in order that the people may hear when I speak with you and so trust you ever after."
- 24:18** Moses entered the cloud, and went up on the mountain. Moses was on the mountain for forty days and forty nights.
- 28:2** You shall make sacred vestments for the glorious adornment of your brother Aaron
- 32:3** So all the people took off the gold rings from their ears, and brought them to Aaron.
- 34:8** And Moses quickly bowed his head toward the earth, and worshiped.

 **LEVITICUS**

- 8:10** Then Moses took the anointing oil and anointed the tabernacle and all that was in it, and consecrated them.
- 8:12** He poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head and anointed him, to consecrate him.
- 11:45** For I am the Lord who brought you up from the land of Egypt, to be your God; you shall be holy, for I am holy.
- 18:5** You shall keep my statutes and my ordinances; by doing so one shall live: I am the Lord.
- 19:11** You shall not steal; you shall not deal falsely; and you shall not lie to one another.
- 20:07** Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy; for I am the Lord your God.
- 26:2** You shall keep my sabbaths and reverence my sanctuary: I am the Lord.
- 27:30** All tithes from the land, whether the seed from the ground or the fruit from the tree, are the Lord's; they are holy to the Lord.

 **NUMBERS**

- 6:25** The LORD make his face to shine upon you, and be gracious to you:
- 6:26** The LORD lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace.

**14:8** If the LORD is pleased with us, he will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that flows with milk and honey.

**35:34** You shall not defile the land in which you live, in which I also dwell; for I the LORD dwell among the Israelites

## DEUTERONOMY

**1:9** At that time I said to you, "I am unable by myself to bear you.

**1:10** The LORD your God has multiplied you, so that today you are as numerous as the stars of heaven.

**2:27** "If you let me pass through your land, I will travel only along the road; I will turn aside neither to the right nor to the left.

**3:22** Do not fear them, for it is the LORD your God who fights for you.

**4:41** Then Moses set apart on the east side of the Jordan three cities

**4:31** Because the LORD your God is a merciful God, he will neither abandon you nor destroy you; he will not forget the covenant with your ancestors that he swore to them.

**5:6** I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery;

**5:12** Observe the Sabbath day and keep it holy, as the LORD your God commanded you.

**5:11** You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not acquit anyone who misuses his name.

**8:6** Therefore keep the commandments of the LORD your God, by walking in his ways and by fearing him.

**10:19** You shall also love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.

**10:22** Your ancestors went down to Egypt seventy persons; and now the LORD your God has made you as numerous as the stars in heaven.

**20:10** When you draw near to a town to fight against it, offer it terms of peace.

**28:10** All the peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they shall be afraid of you.

**30:8** Then you shall again obey the LORD, observing all his commandments that I am commanding you today

**30:15** See, I have set before you today life and prosperity, death and adversity.

## JOSHUA

**1:9** I hereby command you: Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened or dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

**3:05** Then Joshua said to the people, "Sanctify yourselves; for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you."

**5:15** The commander of the army of the Lord said to Joshua, "Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place where you stand is holy." And Joshua did so.

**10:25** And Joshua said to them, "Do not be afraid or dismayed; be strong and courageous; for thus the Lord will do to all the enemies against whom you fight."

**21:45** Not one of all the good promises that the Lord had made to the house of Israel had failed; all came to pass.

**23:11** Be very careful, therefore, to love the Lord your God.

**24:21** And the people said to Joshua, "No, we will serve the Lord!"

**24:24** The people said to Joshua, "The Lord our God we will serve, and him we will obey."

## JUDGES

**2:16** Then the Lord raised up judges, who delivered them out of the power of those who plundered them.

**4:8** Barach said to her, "If you will go with me, I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go".

**5:3** "Hear, O kings; give ear O princes; to the Lord I will sing, I will make melody to the Lord, the God of Israel"

**5:5** The mountains quaked before the Lord, the One of Sinai before the Lord, the God of Israel

**6:12** The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said to him, "The Lord is with you, you mighty warrior"

**6:23** But the LORD said to him, "Peace be to you; do not fear, you shall not die."

**8:23** Gideon said to them, "I will not rule over you, and my son will not rule over you; the Lord will rule over you"

## RUTH

**1:14** Then they wept aloud again. Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth clung to her.

**2:4** Just then Boaz came from Bethlehem. He said to the reapers, "The LORD be with you." They answered, "The LORD bless you."

**3:1** Naomi her mother-in-law said to her, "My daughter, I need to seek some security for you, so that it may be well with you.

**3:9** He said, "Who are you?" And she answered, "I am Ruth, your servant; spread your cloak over your servant, for you are next-of-kin."

## 1 SAMUEL

**1:10** She was deeply distressed and prayed to the Lord, and wept bitterly.

**2:2** "There is no Holy One like the Lord, no one besides you; there is no Rock like our God.

**2:26** Now the boy Samuel continued to grow both in stature and in favor with the Lord and with the people.

**3:19** As Samuel grew up, the Lord was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

**18:3** Then Jonathan made a covenant with David, because he loved him as his own soul.

- 18:14** David had success in all his undertakings, for the Lord was with him.
- 24:13** As the ancient proverb says, 'Out of the wicked comes forth wickedness,' but my hand shall not be against you.
- 24:17** He said to David, "You are more righteous than I; for you have repaid me good, whereas I have repaid you evil.

## 2 SAMUEL

- 5:10** And David became greater and greater, for the Lord, the God of hosts, was with him.
- 7:13** He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.
- 7:28** And now, O Lord God, you are God, and your words are true, and you have promised this good thing to your servant;
- 22:2** He said, "the Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer",
- 22:21** The Lord rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands he recompensed me.
- 22:28** You deliver a humble people, but your eyes are upon the haughty to bring them down.
- 22:29** Indeed, you are my lamp, O Lord, the Lord lightens my darkness
- 22:33** The God who has girded me with strength has opened wide my path.

## 1 KINGS

- 3:8** And your servant is in the midst of the people whom you have chosen, a great people so numerous they cannot be numbered or counted.
- 3:14** If you will walk in my ways, keeping my statutes and my commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your life."
- 4:32** He composed three thousand proverbs, and his songs numbered a thousand and five.
- 6:13** I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will not forsake my people Israel.
- 8:13** I have built you an exalted house, a place for you to dwell forever."
- 8:23** He said, "O LORD, God of Israel, there is no God like you in heaven above or on earth beneath, keeping covenant and steadfast love with your servants who walk before you with all their heart.
- 8:57** The LORD our God be with us, as he was with our ancestors; may he not leave us or abandon us.
- 13:16** But he said, "I cannot return with you or go in with you, nor will I eat food or drink water with you in this place.
- 17:16** The jar of meal was not emptied, neither did the jug of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD that he spoke by Elijah.
- 22:23** So you see, the LORD has put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these your prophets; the LORD has decreed disaster for you."

## 2 KINGS

- 5:10** Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, "Go, wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh shall be restored, and you shall be clean."
- 6:16** He replied, "Do not be afraid, for there are more with us than there are with them."
- 17:39** But you shall worship the Lord your God; he will deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies.
- 18:05** He relied on the Lord, the God of Israel, so that there was no one like him among all the kings of Judah after him or among those who were before him.
- 19:1** When King Hezekiah heard it, he tore his clothes, covered himself with sackcloth, and went into the house of the Lord.
- 20:2** Then Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the Lord.
- 23:21** The king commanded all the people, "Keep the passover to the Lord your God as prescribed in this book of the covenant."
- 23:23** But in the eighteenth year of King Josiah this Passover was kept to the Lord in Jerusalem.

## 1 CHRONICLES

- 16:11** Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his presence continually!
- 16:14** He is the LORD our God; his judgments are in all the earth.
- 16:25** For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; he is to be revered above all gods.
- 29:13** And now, our God, we give thanks to you and praise your glorious name.

## 2 CHRONICLES

- 1:10** Give me now wisdom and knowledge to go out and come in before this people, for who can rule this great people of yours?"
- 2:5** The house that I am about to build will be great, for our God is greater than other gods.
- 6:9** nevertheless, you shall not build the house, but your son who shall be born to you shall build the house for my name.'
- 6:19** Have regard to your servant's prayer and his plea, O LORD my God, heeding the cry and the prayer that your servant prays to you.
- 7:15** Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place.
- 12:12** Because he humbled himself, the wrath of the LORD turned from him, so as not to destroy them completely; moreover, conditions were good in Judah.
- 12:14** He did evil, for he did not set his heart to seek the LORD.
- 15:7** But you, take courage! Do not let your hands be weak, for your work shall be rewarded."

 **EZRA**

- 5:15** He said to him, "Take these vessels; go and put them in the temple in Jerusalem, and let the house of God be rebuilt on its site."
- 7:10** For Ezra had set his heart to study the law of the Lord, and to do it, and to teach the statutes and ordinances in Israel.
- 7:27** Blessed be the Lord, the God of our ancestors, who put such a thing as this into the heart of the king to glorify the house of the Lord in Jerusalem.
- 8:23** So we fasted and petitioned our God for this, and he listened to our entreaty.
- 9:3** When I heard this, I tore my garment and my mantle and pulled hair from my head and beard and sat appalled.
- 9:10** "And now, our God, what shall we say after this? For we have forsaken your commandments.
- 10:4** Take action, for it is your duty, and we are with you; be strong, and do it.
- 10:5** Then Ezra stood up and made the leading priests, the Levites, and all Israel swear that they would do as had been said. So they swore.

 **NEHEMIAH**

- 1:8** Remember the word that you commanded your servant Moses, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the peoples'
- 1:10** They are your servants and your people, whom you redeemed by your great power and your strong hand.
- 4:9** So we prayed to our God, and set a guard as a protection against them day and night.
- 4:20** Rally to us wherever you hear the sound of the trumpet. Our God will fight for us.
- 5:19** Remember for my good, O my God, all that I have done for this people.
- 8:11** So the Levites stilled all the people, saying, "Be quiet, for this day is holy; do not be grieved."
- 9:9** And you saw the distress of our ancestors in Egypt and heard their cry at the Red Sea.
- 9:21** Forty years you sustained them in the wilderness so that they lacked nothing; their clothes did not wear out and their feet did not swell.

 **TOBIT**

- 4:10** For almsgiving delivers from death and keeps you from going into the darkness.
- 4:11** Indeed, almsgiving, for all who practice it, is an excellent offering in the presence of the Most High.
- 5:20** For the life that is given to us by the Lord is enough for us".
- 13:3** Acknowledge him before the nations, O children of Israel, for he has scattered you among them.



## JUDITH

- 4:9** And every man of Israel cried out to God with great fervor, and they humbled themselves with much fasting.
- 5:17** As long as they did not sin against their God they prospered, for the God who hates iniquity is with them.
- 8:08** No one spoke ill of her, for she feared God with great devotion.
- 8:32** Then Judith said to them, "Listen to me. I am about to do something that will go down through all generations of our descendants.
- 9:12** Please, please, God of my father, God of the heritage of Israel, Lord of heaven and earth, Creator of the waters, King of all your creation, hear my prayer!
- 11:6** If you follow the words of your servant, God will accomplish something through you, and my lord will not fail to achieve his purposes.
- 14:9** When she had finished, the people raised a great shout and made a joyful noise in their town.
- 16:25** No one ever again spread terror among the Israelites during the lifetime of Judith or for a long time after her death.



## ESTHER

- 8:6** For how can I bear to see the calamity that is coming on my people? For how can I bear to see the destruction of my kindred?
- 8:16** For the Jews there was light and gladness, joy and honour.
- 10:4** And Mordecai said, "These things have come from God".
- 10:12** And God remembered his people and vindicated his inheritance.



## 1 MACCABEES

- 3:19** It is not on the size of the army that victory in battle depends, but strength comes from heaven.
- 7:37** "You chose this house to be called by your name and to be for your people a house of prayer and supplication.
- 9:21** "How is the mighty fallen, the savior of Israel!"
- 13:46** They said, "Do not treat us according to our wicked acts but according to your mercy."



## 2 MACCABEES

- 1:4** May he open your heart to his law and his commandments, and may he bring peace.
- 1:6** We are now praying for you here.
- 1:29** Plant your people in your holy place, as Moses promised.
- 1:30** Then the priests sang the hymns.

- 3:2** It came about that the kings themselves honored the place and glorified the temple with the finest presents.
- 6:16** Therefore he never withdraws his mercy from us. Although he disciplines us with calamities, he does not forsake his own people.
- 7:19** But do not think that you will go unpunished for having tried to fight against God!
- 7:29** Do not fear this butcher but prove worthy of your brothers. Accept death, so that in God's mercy I may get you back again along with your brothers.

## **JOB**

- 1:21** And he said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return; the LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."
- 4:8** As I have seen, those who plow iniquity and sow trouble reap the same.
- 4:9** By the breath of God they perish, and by the blast of his anger they are consumed.
- 10:12** You have granted me life and steadfast love, and your care has preserved my spirit.
- 13:17** Listen carefully to my words and let my declaration be in your ears.
- 19:25** For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at last he will stand upon the earth;
- 27:4** My lips will not speak falsehood, and my tongue will not utter deceit.
- 28:28** And he said to humankind, "Truly, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding"
- 34:21** For his eyes are upon the ways of mortals, and he sees all their steps.
- 42:10** And the LORD restored the fortunes of Job, when he had prayed for his friends; and the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

## **PSALM**

- 1:1** Happy are those who do not follow the advice of the wicked or take the path that sinners tread or sit in the seat of scoffers,
- 1:6** For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
- 4:5** Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the LORD.
- 8:9** O LORD, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth!
- 9:9** The LORD is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.
- 11:7** For the LORD is righteous; he loves righteous deeds; the upright shall behold his face.
- 16:3** As for the holy ones in the land, they are the noble ones in whom is all my delight.
- 16:8** I keep the LORD always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.
- 17:5** My steps have held fast to your paths; my feet have not slipped.
- 19:14** Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.
- 20:4** May he grant you your heart's desire and fulfill all your plans.

- 21:4** He asked you for life; you gave it to him—length of days forever and ever.
- 23:1** The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 25:15** My eyes are ever toward the LORD, for he will pluck my feet out of the net.
- 26:12** My foot stands on level ground; in the great congregation I will bless the LORD.
- 27:1** The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- 31:24** Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all you who wait for the LORD.
- 32:1** Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- 32 :8** I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.
- 34:8** O taste and see that the LORD is good; happy are those who take refuge in him.
- 34:14** Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.
- 37:4** Take delight in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart.
- 38:15** But it is for you, O LORD, that I wait; it is you, O Lord my God, who will answer.
- 40:1** I waited patiently for the LORD; he inclined to me and heard my cry.
- 41:1** Happy are those who consider the poor; the LORD delivers them in the day of trouble.
- 46:1** God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
- 50:15** Call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me.”
- 51:5** Indeed, I was born guilty, a sinner when my mother conceived me.
- 55:1** Give ear to my prayer, O God; do not hide yourself from my supplication.
- 55:2** Attend to me and answer me; I am troubled in my complaint.
- 57:2** I cry to God Most High, to God who fulfills his purpose for me.
- 62:1** For God alone my soul waits in silence; from him comes my salvation.
- 63:3** Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.
- 71:1** In you, O LORD, I take refuge; let me never be put to shame.
- 80:3** Restore us, O God; let your face shine, that we may be saved.
- 84:1** How lovely is your dwelling place, LORD of hosts!
- 84:12** O LORD of hosts, happy is everyone who trusts in you.
- 86:7** In the day of my trouble I call on you, for you will answer me.
- 90:1** Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations.
- 91:7** A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
- 92:12** The righteous flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar in Lebanon.
- 102:12** But you, O LORD, are enthroned forever; your name endures to all generations.
- 103:1** Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name.
- 107:1** O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.
- 111.1** Praise the LORD! I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation.
- 115:16** The heavens are the LORD’s heavens, but the earth he has given to human beings.

- 116:1** I love the LORD because he has heard my voice and my supplications.
- 118:1** O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever!
- 118: 24** This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- 119:105** Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
- 119:146** I cry to you; save me, that I may observe your decrees.
- 120:1** In my distress I cry to the LORD, that he may answer me:
- 124:8** Our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth.
- 125:1** Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved but abides forever.
- 126:5** May those who sow in tears reap with shouts of joy.
- 127:3** Sons are indeed a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb a reward.
- 128:1** Happy is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in his ways.
- 129:4** The LORD is righteous; he has cut the cords of the wicked.
- 132:17** There I will cause a horn to sprout up for David; I have prepared a lamp for my anointed one.
- 133:1** How very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in unity!
- 136:1** O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.
- 138:3** On the day I called, you answered me; you increased my strength of soul.
- 139:13** For it was you who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb
- 140:6** I say to the LORD, "You are my God; give ear, O LORD, to the voice of my supplications."
- 141:3** Set a guard over my mouth, O LORD; keep watch over the door of my lips.
- 142:1** With my voice I cry to the LORD; with my voice I make supplication to the LORD.
- 145:18** The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.
- 146:9** The LORD watches over the strangers; he upholds the orphan and the widow, but the way of the wicked he brings to ruin.
- 147:6** The LORD lifts up the downtrodden; he casts the wicked to the ground.
- 150:6** Let everything that breathes praise the LORD! Praise the LORD!



## PROVERBS

- 1:7** The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- 2:6** For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding;
- 3:1** My child, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments;
- 3:5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight.
- 6:20** My child, keep your father's commandment, and do not forsake your mother's teaching.
- 9:10** The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.
- 11:30** The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, but violence takes lives away.
- 12:22** Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who act faithfully are his delight.
- 14:1** The wise woman builds her house, but the foolish tears it down with her own hands.

- 15:2** The tongue of the wise dispenses knowledge, but the mouths of fools pour out folly.
- 16:1** The plans of the mind belong to mortals, but the answer of the tongue is from the Lord.
- 17:6** Grandchildren are the crown of the aged, and the glory of children is their parents.
- 19:11** Those with good sense are slow to anger, and it is their glory to overlook an offense.
- 21:2** All deeds are right in the sight of the doer, but the Lord weighs the heart.
- 22:6** Train children in the right way, and when old, they will not stray.
- 23:13** Do not withhold discipline from your children; if you beat them with a rod, they will not die.
- 30:5** Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
- 31:30** Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.



## ECCLESIASTES

- 3:1** For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven.
- 3:20** All go to one place; all are from the dust, and all turn to dust again.
- 4:9** Two are better than one because they have a good reward for their toil.
- 7:1** A good name is better than precious ointment and the day of death than the day of birth.
- 7:5** It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise than to hear the song of fools.
- 10:12** Words spoken by the wise bring them favour, but the lips of fools consume them.
- 12:1** Remember your creator in the days of your youth, before the days of trouble come and the years draw near when you say, "I have no pleasure in them".



## SONG OF SOLOMON

- 1:8** If you do not know, fairest among women, follow the tracks of the flock and pasture your kids beside the shepherds' tents.
- 2:2** As a lily among brambles, so is my love among maidens.
- 2:15** Catch us the foxes, the little foxes, that ruin the vineyards—for our vineyards are in blossom."
- 8:9** If she is a wall, we will build upon her a battlement of silver, but if she is a door, we will enclose her with boards of cedar.



## WISDOM OF SOLOMON

- 1:15** For righteousness is immortal.
- 5:19** He will take holiness as an invincible shield.
- 7:16** For both we and our words are in his hand, as are all understanding and skill in crafts.
- 9:4** Give me the wisdom that sits by your throne and do not reject me from among your servants.
- 11:23** But you are merciful to all, for you can do all things and you overlook people's sins, so that they may repent.
- 13:8** Yet again, not even they are to be excused.

- 14:9** For equally hateful to God are the ungodly and their ungodliness.  
**15:1** But you, our God, are kind and true, patient, and ruling all things in mercy.

 **SIRACH**

- 1:1** All wisdom is from the Lord, and with him it remains forever.  
**1:12** The fear of the Lord delights the heart and gives gladness and joy and long life.  
**2:8** You who fear the Lord, trust in him, and your reward will not be lost.  
**2:11** For the Lord is compassionate and merciful; he forgives sins and saves in times of distress.  
**3:25** Without eyes there is no light; without knowledge there is no wisdom.  
**4:11** Wisdom teaches her children and gives help to those who seek her.  
**5:11** Be quick to hear, but deliberate in answering.  
**6:14** Faithful friends are a sturdy shelter; whoever finds one has found a treasure.  
**6:35** Be ready to listen to every Godly discourse and let no wise proverbs escape you.  
**7:27** With all your heart honour your father and do not forget the birth pangs of your mother.  
**7:29** With all your soul, fear the Lord, revere his priests.  
**10:14** The Lord overthrows the thrones of rulers, and enthrones the lowly in their place.  
**11:3** The bee is small among flying creatures, but what it produces is the best of sweet things.  
**11:14** Good things and bad, life and death, poverty and wealth come from the Lord.  
**30:22** A joyful heart is life itself, and rejoicing lengthens one's lifespan.

 **ISAIAH**

- 1:9** If the LORD of hosts had not left us a few survivors, we would have been like Sodom and become like Gomorrah.  
**5:21** Ah, you who are wise in your own eyes, and shrewd in your own sight !  
**8:13** But the LORD of hosts, him you shall regard as holy; let him be your fear, and let him be your dread.  
**9:2** The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness— on them light has shined. '  
**11:5** Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist and faithfulness the belt around his loins. '  
**26:4** Trust in the LORD forever, for in the Lord you have an everlasting rock.  
**32:1** See, a king will reign in righteousness, and princes will rule with justice.  
**35:3** Strengthen the weak hands and make firm the feeble knee'  
**40:1** Comfort, O comfort my people, says your God.  
**41:10** Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God; I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will uphold you with my victorious right hand.  
**42:18** Listen, you who are deaf, and you who are blind, look up and see!

- 43:11** I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no savior.
- 45:5** I am the LORD, and there is no other; besides me there is no god. I arm you, though you do not know me,
- 46:9** Remember the former things of old, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like me,
- 55:6** Seek the LORD while he may be found; call upon him while he is near; '
- 59:1** See, the LORD's arm is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear. '

## JEREMIAH

- 1:6** Then I said, "Ah, Lord God! Truly I do not know how to speak, for I am only a boy."
- 1:8** Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, says the Lord.
- 6:27** I have made you a tester and a refiner among my people so that you may know and test their ways.
- 16:17** For my eyes are on all their ways; they are not hidden from my presence, nor is their iniquity concealed from my sight.
- 17:7** Blessed are those who trust in the Lord, whose trust is the Lord.
- 17:14** Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved; for you are my praise.
- 23:29** Is not my word like fire, says the Lord, and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?
- 32:27** See, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too hard for me?

## LAMENTATIONS

- 3:25** The LORD is good to those who wait for him, to the soul that seeks him.
- 3:40** Let us test and examine our ways, and return to the LORD!
- 3:57** You came near when I called on you; you said, "Do not fear!"
- 5:19** But you, O LORD, reign for ever; your throne endures to all generations.

## BARUCH

- 1:18** We have disobeyed him and have not heeded the voice of the Lord our God, to walk in the statutes of the Lord that he set before us.
- 2:6** "The Lord our God is in the right, but there is open shame on us and our ancestors this very day.'
- 3:5** Do not remember the iniquities of our ancestors, but in this crisis remember your power and your name.
- 4:4** Happy are we, O Israel, for we know what is pleasing to God.
- 5:1** Take off the garment of your sorrow and affliction, O Jerusalem, and put on forever the beauty of the glory from God.



## EZEKIEL

- 2:7** You shall speak my words to them, whether they hear or refuse to hear, for they are a rebellious house.
- 10:14** Each one had four faces: the first face was that of the cherub, the second face was that of a human, the third that of a lion, and the fourth that of an eagle.
- 28:15** You were blameless in your ways from the day that you were created, until iniquity was found in you.
- 32:14** Then I will make their waters clear and cause their streams to run like oil, says the Lord God.
- 34:31** You are my sheep, the sheep of my pasture and I am your God, says the Lord God.
- 36:29** I will save you from all your uncleannesses, and I will summon the grain and make it abundant and lay no famine upon you.
- 37:3** He said to me, "Mortal, can these bones live?" I answered, "O Lord God, you know."
- 37:5** Thus says the Lord God to these bones: I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live.



## DANIEL

- 9:9** To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness; for we have rebelled against him.
- 12:3** Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky; and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever.



## HOSEA

- 2:16** On that day, says the LORD, you will call me "my husband," and no longer will you call me "my Baal"
- 6:1** "Come, let us return to the LORD, for it is he who has torn, and he will heal us; he has struck down, and he will bind us up.
- 6:6** For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice, the knowledge of God rather than burnt offerings.
- 7:8** Ephraim mixes himself with the peoples; Ephraim is a cake not turned.
- 11:1** When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son.
- 12:5** The LORD the God of hosts, the LORD is his name!
- 12:6** But as for you, return to your God; hold fast to love and justice, and wait continually for your God.
- 13:7** So I will become like a lion to them; like a leopard I will lurk beside the way.
- 13:5** It was I who fed you in the wilderness, in the land of drought.
- 14:5** I will be like the dew to Israel; he shall blossom like the lily; he shall strike root like the forests of Lebanon.



## JOEL

- 2:4** They have the appearance of horses and like war horses they charge.

- 2:12** Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning;
- 2:18** Then the Lord became jealous for his land, and had pity on his people.
- 2:24** The threshing floors shall be full of grain; the vats shall overflow with wine and oil.
- 3:15** The sun and the moon are darkened and the stars withdraw their shining.
- 3:20** But Judah shall be inhabited forever and Jerusalem to all generations.

## **AMOS**

- 5:14** Seek good, and not evil, that you may live; and so, the LORD, the God of hosts, will be with you, just as you have said.
- 5:24** But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.

## **OBADIAH**

- 1:2** I will surely make you least among the nations; you shall be utterly despised.
- 1:4** Though you soar aloft like the eagle, though your nest is set among the stars, from there I will bring you down, says the LORD.

## **JONAH**

- 1:9** "I am a Hebrew," he replied. "I worship the Lord, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land."
- 1:15** So they picked Jonah up and threw him into the sea; and the sea ceased from its raging.
- 1:17** But the Lord provided a large fish to swallow up Jonah, and Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.
- 2:10** Then the Lord spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah out onto the dry land.
- 3:2** "Get up, go to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim to it the message that I tell you."
- 3:4** Jonah began to go into the city, going a day's walk. And he cried out, "Forty days more, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!"

## **MICAH**

- 4:5** For all the peoples walk, each in the name of its God but we will walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever.
- 6:1** Hear what the Lord says: Rise, plead your case before the mountains and let the hills hear your voice.
- 7:7** But as for me, I will look to the Lord, I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me.



## NAHUM

- 1:7** The LORD is good, a stronghold in a day of trouble; he protects those who take refuge in him.
- 1:13** And now I will break off his yoke from you and snap the bonds that bind you.



## HABAKKUK

- 1:7** Dread and fearsome are they; their justice and dignity proceed from themselves.
- 2:02** Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so that a runner may read it."
- 2:14** But the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.
- 2:20** But the Lord is in his holy temple; let all the earth keep silence before him!
- 3:4** The brightness was like the sun; rays came forth from his hand, where his power lay hidden.
- 3:18** Yet I will rejoice in the Lord; I will exult in the God of my salvation.



## ZEPHANIAH

- 1:2** "I will utterly sweep away everything from the face of the earth," says the LORD.
- 3:16** On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: Do not fear O Zion; do not let your hands grow weak.



## HAGGAI

- 1:10** Therefore the heavens above you have withheld the dew, and the earth has withheld its produce.
- 2:8** The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, says the LORD of hosts.
- 2:15** But now, consider what will come to pass from this day on. Before a stone was placed upon a stone in the LORD's temple



## ZECHARIAH

- 1:13** Then the Lord replied with gracious and comforting words to the angel who spoke with me.
- 1:20** Then the Lord showed me four blacksmiths.
- 2:3** Then the angel who spoke with me came forward, and another angel came forward to meet him.
- 4.5** Then the angel who spoke with me answered me, "Do you not know what these are?" I said, "No, my lord."
- 7:13** Just as, when I called, they would not hear, so, when they called, I would not hear, says the Lord of hosts.
- 9:11** As for you also, because of the blood of my covenant with you, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit.
- 14:1** See, a day is coming for the Lord, when the plunder taken from you will be divided in your midst.

**14:9** And the Lord will become king over all the earth; on that day the Lord will be one and his name one.



## MALACHI

- 1:5** Your own eyes shall see this and you shall say, "Great is the Lord beyond the borders of Israel".
- 3:6** For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, have not perished.
- 3:8** Will anyone rob God? Yet you are robbing me! But you say, "How are we robbing you?" In your tithes and offerings!
- 4:4** Remember the teaching of my servant Moses, the statutes and ordinances that I commanded him at Horeb for all Israel.



# **NEW TESTAMENT**



## **MATTHEW**

- 3:2** "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near"
- 3:8** Bear fruit worthy of repentance.
- 5:3** "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 5:9** "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God.
- 5:44** But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,
- 5:48** Be perfect, therefore as your heavenly Father is perfect.
- 6:11** Give us this day our daily bread.
- 6:21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 7:1** Do not judge, so that you may not be judged.
- 7:7** Ask, and it will be given you; Search and you will find; Knock, and the door will be opened for you.
- 10:32** Everyone therefore who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven.
- 11:28** Come to me, all you that are weary and carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.
- 11:30** For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
- 12:50** For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother, and sister, and mother.
- 16:24** Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."
- 18:3** and said, "Truly, I tell you, unless you change and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."
- 18:19** Again, truly I tell you, if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven.
- 19:19** Honor your father and mother; also, you shall love your neighbour as yourself.
- 19:26** But Jesus looked at them and said, "For mortals it is impossible, but for God all things are possible".
- 19:30** But many that are first will be last, and the last first.
- 21:22** Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will receive.
- 22:14** For many are called, but few are chosen.

- 22:32** I am the God of Abraham, the God of Issac, and the God of Jacob, he is God not of the dead but of the living.
- 22:37** He said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."
- 23:12** All who exalts themselves will be humbled, and all who humble themselves will be exalted.
- 24:35** Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

## MARK

- 1:11** And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; <sup>[a]</sup>with you I am well pleased."
- 3:35** Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."
- 4:25** For to those who have, more will be given; and from those who have nothing, even what they have will be taken away."
- 7:23** All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."
- 10:25** It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."
- 13:30** Truly I tell you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have taken place.
- 14:28** But after I am raised up, I will go before you to Galilee."
- 16:15** And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation.

## LUKE

- 2:14** "Glory to God in the highest heaven and on earth peace among those whom he favors!"
- 11:9** So I say to you, Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you.
- 12:40** You also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour."
- 14:11** For all who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.
- 15:21** Then the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'
- 19:10** For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost.
- 21:18** But not a hair of your head will perish.
- 21:37** Every day he was teaching in the temple, and at night he would go out and spend the night on the Mount of Olives, as it was called.
- 22:19** Then he took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
- 22:42** "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me; yet, not my will but yours be done."
- 23:42** Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."
- 24:05** The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen.

## JOHN

- 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, the Word was with God and the Word was God.
- 2:5** His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."
- 3:3** Jesus answered him, "Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above."
- 3:16** For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.
- 6:47** Very truly, I tell you, whoever believes has eternal life.
- 6:48** I am the bread of life.
- 6:56** Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood abide in me, and I in them.
- 7:24** Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment.
- 8:12** Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life."
- 8:15** You judge by human standards; I judge no one.
- 10:11** I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.
- 10:30** The Father and I are one.
- 10:27** My sheep hear my voice. I know them and they follow me.
- 11:25** Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; those who believe in me, even though they die, they live,
- 12:46** I have come as light into the world, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in the darkness.
- 13:34** I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another.
- 14:6** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me.
- 14:14** If in my name you ask me for anything, I will do it.
- 14:15** If you love me, you will keep my commandments.
- 15:1** I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower.
- 17:17** Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.
- 20:28** Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!"
- 20:29** Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

## ACTS

- 2:42** They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

- 3:6** But Peter said, "I have no silver or gold, but what I have I give you; in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, stand up and walk."
- 4:12** There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved."
- 6:8** Stephen, full of grace and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.
- 9:20** And immediately he began to proclaim Jesus in the synagogues, saying, "He is the Son of God."
- 11:15** And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as it had upon us at the beginning.
- 15:11** On the contrary, we believe that we will be saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, just as they will."
- 28:16** When we came into Rome, Paul was allowed to live by himself, with the soldier who was guarding him.

## ROMANS

- 1:17** For in it the righteousness of God is revealed through faith for faith; as it is written, "The one who is righteous will live by faith."
- 2:6** For he will repay according to each one's deeds:
- 5:8** But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.
- 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 7:12** So the law is holy, and the commandment is holy and just and good.
- 8:1** Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
- 8:14** For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.
- 10:9** Because if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
- 10:13** For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."
- 12:15** Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep.

## 1 CORINTHIANS

- 1:25** For God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength.
- 3:6** I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth.
- 3:11** For no other can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.
- 3:16** Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?
- 10:31** So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God.
- 12:14** Indeed, the body does not consist of one member but of many.
- 13:4** Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant;

**13:13** And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.

**15:26** The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

**15:33** Do not be deceived; "Bad company ruins good morals."

**16:13** Keep alert, stand firm in your faith, be courageous, be strong.

**16:14** Let all that you do be done in love.

**16:23** The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you.

## 2 CORINTHIANS

**1:22** By putting his seal on us and giving us his Spirit in our hearts as a first installment.

**3:17** Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

**5:7** For we walk by faith, not by sight.

**5:17** So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

**6:3** We are putting no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry,

**9:15** Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

**10:17** "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

**13:9** For we rejoice when we are weak and you are strong. This is what we pray for, that you may become perfect.

## GALATIANS

**1:5** To whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

**3:27** As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

**3:28** There is no longer Jew or Greek; there is no longer slave or free; there is no longer male and female, for all of you are one in Christ Jesus.

**4:7** So you are no longer a slave but a child, and if a child then also an heir through God.

**5:5** For through the Spirit, by faith, we eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness.

**5:14** For the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

**5:16** Live by the Spirit, I say, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh.

**6:2** Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

**6:9** So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up.

**6:14** May I never boast of anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

## EPHESIANS

- 1:16** I do not cease to give thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers.
- 2:8** For by grace you have been saved by grace, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God.
- 2:13** But now in Christ Jesus, you who once were far off have been bought near by the blood of Christ.
- 3:13** I pray therefore that you may not lose heart over my sufferings for you; they are your glory.
- 4:26** Be angry but do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger.
- 5:8** For once you were darkness, but now in the Lord you are light. Live as children of light.
- 5:10** Try to find out what is pleasing to the Lord.
- 6:1** Children, obey your parents in the Lord for this is right.
- 6:2** “Honour your father and mother” – This is the first commandment with a promise.
- 6:10** Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power.
- 6:11** Put on the whole armour of God so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- 6:17** Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the spirit which is the word of God.

## PHILIPPIANS

- 1:9** And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight
- 1:21** For to me, living is Christ and dying is gain.
- 2:5** Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,
- 2:14** Do all things without murmuring and arguing,
- 4:13** I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

## COLOSSIANS

- 1:14** In whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
- 1:17** He himself is before all things, and in him all things hold together.
- 2:17** These are only a shadow of what is to come, but the body belongs to Christ.
- 3:2** Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.
- 3:14** Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
- 3:20** Children, obey your parents in everything, for this is your acceptable duty in the Lord.
- 4:2** Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with thanksgiving.
- 4:5** Conduct yourselves wisely toward outsiders, making the most of the time.

## 1 THESSALONIANS

- 3:8** For we now live, if you continue to stand firm in the Lord.
- 4:07** For God did not call us to impurity, but in holiness.
- 5:17** Pray without ceasing.
- 5:18** Give thanks in all circumstances for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
- 5:21** But test everything; hold fast what is good.
- 5:22** Abstain from every form of evil.
- 5:24** The one who calls you is faithful and he will do this.
- 5:27** I solemnly command you by the Lord that this letter be read to all of them.

## 2 THESSALONIANS

- 1:2** Grace to you and peace from God our<sup>[a]</sup> Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2:5** Do you not remember that I told you these things when I was still with you?
- 3:5** May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ.
- 3:13** Brothers and sisters, do not be weary in doing what is right.
- 3:15** Do not regard them as enemies, but warn them as believers.

## 1 TIMOTHY

- 1:5** But the aim of such instruction is love that comes from a pure heart, a good conscience, and sincere faith.
- 1:8** Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it legitimately;
- 1:17** To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.
- 2:8** I desire, then, that in every place the men should pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or argument;
- 5:1** Do not speak harshly to an older man, but speak to him as to a father, to younger men as brothers.
- 6:10** For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, and in their eagerness to be rich some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pains.

## 2 TIMOTHY

- 2:3** Share in suffering like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.
- 2:11** The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him.
- 4:7** I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.
- 4:22** The Lord be with your spirit. Grace be with you.

## TITUS

- 1:15** To the pure all things are pure, but to the corrupt and unbelieving nothing is pure. Their very minds and consciences are corrupted.
- 2:7** Show yourself in all respects a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, gravity,
- 2:11** For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all,
- 2:15** Declare these things; exhort and reprove with all authority. Let no one look down on you.
- 3:6** This Spirit he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- 3:15** All who are with me send greetings to you. Greet those who love us in the faith. Grace be with all of you.

## PHILEMON

- 1:3** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1:4** When I remember you in my prayers, I always thank my God.
- 1:8** For this reason, though I am bold enough in Christ to command you to do your duty.
- 1:11** Formerly he was useless to you, but now he is indeed useful both to you and to me.
- 1:12** I am sending him, that is, my own heart, back to you.
- 1:17** So if you consider me your partner, welcome him as you would welcome me.

## HEBREWS

- 2:18** Because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested.
- 3:4** For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.
- 10:10** And it is by God's will that we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
- 11:1** Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
- 13:1** Let mutual love continue.
- 13:8** Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
- 13:16** Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

## JAMES

- 1:6** But ask in faith, never doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind;
- 1:8** For the doubter, being double-minded and unstable in every way, must not expect to receive anything from the Lord.

- 2:8** You do well if you really fulfill the royal law according to the scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself.
- 2:17** So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead.
- 3:5** So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great exploits. How great a forest is set ablaze by a small fire!
- 3:10** From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this ought not to be so.
- 4:10** Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.
- 4:17** Anyone, then, who knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, commits sin.

## 1 PETER

- 2:19** For it is a commendable thing if, being aware of God, a person endures pain while suffering unjustly.
- 2:21** For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you should follow in his steps.
- 4:6** For this is the reason the gospel was proclaimed even to the dead, so that, though they had been judged in the flesh as everyone is judged, they might live in the spirit as God does.
- 4:8** Above all, maintain constant love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins.
- 4:16** Yet if any of you suffers as a Christian, do not consider it a disgrace, but glorify God because you bear this name.
- 5:7** Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you.

## 2 PETER

- 1:2** May grace and peace be yours in abundance in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.
- 3:8** But do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like one day.
- 3:13** But, in accordance with his promise, we wait for new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness is at home.

## 1 JOHN

- 2:9** Whoever says, "I am in the light," while hating a brother or sister, is still in the darkness.
- 2:17** And the world and its desire are passing away, but those who do the will of God live forever.
- 3:4** Everyone who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness; sin is lawlessness.
- 3:11** For this is the message you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.
- 4:8** Whoever does not love does not know God, for God is love.
- 4:19** We love because he first loved us.

**5:4** For whatever is born of God conquers the world. And this is the victory that conquers the world, our faith.

**5:12** Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

## **2 JOHN**

**1:3** Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us from God the Father and from Jesus Christ, the Father's Son, in truth and love.

**1:6** And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment just as you have heard it from the beginning—you must walk in it.

**1:8** Be on your guard, so that you do not lose what we have worked for but may receive a full reward.

## **3 JOHN**

**1:4** I have no greater joy than this, to hear that my children are walking in the truth.

**1:11** Beloved, do not imitate what is evil but imitate what is good. Whoever does good is from God; whoever does evil has not seen God.

**1:8** Therefore, we ought to support such people, so that we may become co-workers with the truth.

## **JUDE**

**1:2** May mercy, peace, and love be yours in abundance.

**1:8** Yet in the same way these dreamers also defile the flesh, reject authority, and slander the glorious ones.

**1:19** It is these worldly people, devoid of the Spirit, who are causing divisions.

**1:20** But you, beloved, build yourselves up on your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit;

**1:22** And have mercy on some who are wavering;

## **REVELATION**

**1:3** Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of the prophecy, and blessed are those who hear and who keep what is written in it; for the time is near.

**1:8** "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.

**13:9** Let anyone who has an ear listen.

**16:7** And I heard the altar respond, "Yes, O Lord God, the Almighty, your judgments are true and just!"

**19:16** On his robe and on his thigh he has a name inscribed, "King of kings and Lord of lords."

**20:15** And anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

**21:1** Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.

- 21:23** And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God is its light, and its lamp is the Lamb.
- 22:7** "See, I am coming soon! Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."
- 22:13** I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.
- 22:21** The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all the saints.
